Directors of small NFP organisations with an annual income of \$2-million or less, or aspiring directors, executives and senior managers of NFP organisations are encouraged to apply.

Successful applicants will undertake the highly regarded AICD Governance Foundations for NFP Directors course between August 2023 and June 2024.

The COVID-19 pandemic and various royal commissions have had major implications for the NFP and charitable sector, with greater demands and expectations being placed on organisations and their boards.
